Bronze Medals for Clout seem likely for both Tasmanian representatives at the nationals this year. Elizabeth Fluck (Paringa) and Russell Hoffman (Hobart Archers) both came third in their respective divisions (despite debilitating colds). Well done both! If you want to get into Clout, the state championships will be in Hobart on 5-6 September.

New QRE rounds for Beginners

To help new archers compete, the AST has put two new rounds into the QRE schedule for beginners. They are:

Beginners Round 1 36 arrows each

Beginners Round 2 36 arrows 30m, 25m (122cm) each

That's half the arrows shot in a full QRE, and gives some younger members a chance to get into the State Ranking list.

Goal: To encourage new and existing members to take part in a monthly event leading to QREs, tournaments or personal goals.

Strategy: Most available time and place to suit the majority of members. (Suggest Sat afternoons – NOW ADOPTED - Ed).

- Prizes for 1st 2nd 3rd based on a handicap system of a generic Trophy or Medal. Recognition of all results in monthly newsletter.
- Incorporate as part of any scheduled training.

Key Performance Indicators

- Regular attendance (Could downgrade like national rankings)
- New archers coming through
- Progression through OZ Bow or national program.
- Update personal scoring book of goals/achievements. (Archery Aust)

Assumptions

- Most people want to take part to practice and get better for tournaments or just their own goals.
- People want to be told what to do as they have no idea.
- Beginners would probably like to collect a few trophies/medals starting out. I was chuffed. [©]

My experience

There is no apparent path from turning up at public sessions (Perhaps an A3 flowchart reading left to right) of possible pathways of achievement if you want to go further. I could do this if people considered it a good idea) ie: Public Session (N goes)-> start Oz Bow -> Member -> Sat Afternoon training 10 steps (continue OZ Bow and take part in Monthly Medal) -> Tournaments -> QREs. Peter Fisher invited me to the Saturday afternoon sessions, but there doesn't seem to be a formal/structured pathway once you are a member. I set my own goals and discussed these with Nick Reaburn (Club Coach). I'm still wondering what Taylah had to do to become a Master Archer. I must ask someone about this! As a sport I expect to take part regularly and train regularly. The social camaraderie is good within the club.
