Remember when you register on Archers Diary scroll to the bottom of the event selection, and you will find Flu Flu Mini Clout 40,50 and 60 mtrs

Planning is underway for a new format next year which will incorporate the PopinJay, the Wand, Tic Tac Toe, and other targets still to be refined. We are thinking of holding the shoot on the 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month of which I think there are 3 next year, this would make the first shoot on April 29<sup>th</sup> if the range is available.

We think it will be a progressive shoot over several different targets with the highest accumulated score winning. It will include specialty targets as well as standard targets over distances from 20 – 30 mtrs, all different and designed to challenge the shooter at the same time as having a lot of fun.

There will be a mix of Flu Flu arrows with points and blunts as well as your own arrows, think Archery Decathlon.

We will be testing new targets over the next couple of months, so look out for us on the range.
