A Reminder for COVID-19

We now have badges awarded for the longbow shoot based on your score.

I realised that it was important for people to have a sense of achievement and be rewarded for shooting well in this format after speaking with members.

The awards aren't affiliated with Archery Australia or World Archery but those who have earned them know that they deserve them in our club shoot through hard work, practise and perseverance.

I say, well done for your achievements.

Here is how you get awarded the badges.

Once you shoot a particular score you will receive the appropriate longbow badge.

You will receive the badge once for your achievement.

Eg. once you score a (350<399) you would attain the 350 club badge.

You won't receive any badge for a lesser score posted than your current PB.
